***PLAN Test for All Sophomores:** On Wednesday, November 6th we will be administering the PLAN test to all Sophomores. This test is a state required test for all Sophomores and it is a test that helps students prepare for the ACT test their Junior year. All Juniors and Seniors will not be required to attend school on November 6th. More information on this test will be given later. Please make sure no appointments are made for your Sophomore student, so they can take the test at school on this date. Buses will run on this day and all Sophomore students will be excused at 11:15 AM. (Breakfast **only** will be served on this day.)

***Sterling Scholars:** Seniors who would like to be nominated as a Sterling Scholar may now pick up applications in the Counseling Office. MMHS will recognize 14 Senior students for excellence in scholarship, leadership, and community service. These students will participate in a state-wide scholarship competition in February. Applications will be due on November 8.

***Driver Education Announcement:** The November Driver Education class begins on Monday, November 11th, at 6:00 AM in room E-202. For all students enrolled in the November Driver Education class, there will be a mandatory meeting in Mr. Hyer's room, E-202, right after school this Thursday, November 7th. Physicals are a yearly requirement (once per year, not per sport).
