ACT Test for Junior Students

On Tuesday, February 26th the ACT will be administered to all Junior students. Sophomore and Senior students do not need to attend on this day.

Juniors will need to bring with them a no.2 pencil and an approved calculator if they wish to use one for the math portion of the test. All of the problems on the math test can be solved without the use of a calculator. If you are unsure if your calculator is approved please visit www.act.org/calculator-policy.html. The test will be given by computer and will include the Essay portion of the exam. Most students will be using chrome books for testing. The school has a limited number of computer mice available so if you would like to have a mouse to use with the chrome book you may bring one with you.

Testing will begin promptly at 7:50 so please be on time. A list of room assignments will be posted by the Counseling Office and Library. Testing will take approximately four hours and buses will arrive to pick up students at 12:15.

Look for the pdf titled **Preparing for the ACT Taken Online**. This page also has a download for the **TestNav App** through which you can access practice tests.

Cell phones, smart watches, or any other electronic device that can connect to the internet are not allowed to be used at any time during the test, including breaks.

Please make arrangements to leave these items at home on test day.

ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

Pre-participation Physicals

We are hosting an evening for pre-participation physicals. It will be here at Maple Mountain High School on Wednesday, February 20th, from 4:00-5:30 pm on campus in the athletes commons and gym (Physicians will be in attendance for these exams). This is for anyone who needs a physical for participation in athletics (including try-outs) or can be done for other things such as scout camps etc. The cost is \$20.00 cash or check. These funds are a fundraiser for our sports medicine budget and helps us purchase necessary items to care for our athletes.

Just a reminder that to participate in a sport at MMHS at any time during the 2018-19 school year, your physical has to be dated on or after April 15, 2018 and will be valid unit Jul 15, 2019. SheTech Explorer Day

SheTech Explorer Day is a FREE hands-on tech conference for girls 9th through 12th grade. This day-long event will include hands-on workshops in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM). Girls who attend will have access to internships, receive a SheTech certificate, receive pathway information and become part of a community to help girls have opportunities in STEM.

The day is tech interactive and enables girls to experience, innovate and create. Girls will explore robotics, computer programming, digital media, health and microbiology. The girls will also get to experience the TechChallenge where they work with industry mentors to ideate, solve and pitch their solutions. MMHS will be providing a bus and lunch is included. ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMS

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Maple Mountain High School desires that all students take AP exams for the AP classes that they have taken. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition. For the 2019 AP exams, students at Maple Mountain High School will be registering online. This registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access.

Online Exam registration will begin on Wed, Jan 2, 2019 at 12:00 AM and end on Wed, Mar 6, 2019 at 11:59 PM. In order to register, students should click on the link provided on the school website or visit www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/450423 to register. To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end. We know that parents may desire to register their students for exams. We strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.

Maple Mountain High School is excited to offer families the convenience of paying exam fees online at the time of registration. Please be sure to have a **credit card or debit card available before beginning registration**. Paying online is a great way to make sure that payment has been made while avoiding mailing payment. This year each AP exam costs \$99.00.

Here are the important dates for the registration process:

- Wed, Jan 2, 2019 at 12:00 AM - Registration Begins
- Wed, Mar 6, 2019 at 11:59 PM - Registration Ends
- Mon, Mar 11, 2019 at 11:59 PM - Registrations that have not been paid for will be cancelled and exams will not be ordered.

MMHS Theatre Department




Hello Parents,

Many of you have a child who does coursework on Canvas. Some of you may not be aware that you can be a parent observer in Canvas. Once you are enrolled as an observer to your child's Canvas account, you will be able to view assignments, course events, and grades. Instructions on how to become a parent observer in a Nebo Canvas account are below. Adding Parents as Observers in Canvas

First, the STUDENT needs to get a code for their parent/guardian

1. The student goes to their Account settings in Canvas (profile pic)
2. Choose Settings




3. Choose Pair with Observer

- Student will receive a code they give to their parent/guardian so they can create a paired account. The code expires after 24 hours.

1. Go to the Nebo home page
2. Hover over or click on the Parents tab
3. Choose Canvas
