*Nebo District Student Dress and Grooming Policy: With the warm weather upon us and that time of year when everyone wants to wear their fun summer clothing, we would like to remind our students (and parents) of the district's dress and grooming policy, as listed below. We appreciate your support in adhering to this policy!

Student Dress and Grooming (Student Handbook Pg 48):

- 3. SPECIFIC STANDARDS:
- 3.1 Students shall comply with the following dress and grooming standards at school and at school activities or events:
- 3.1.1 Clothing will be modest, neat, clean, and in good repair. Modesty includes covering shoulders, midriff, back, underwear, and cleavage.
- 3.1.2 Inappropriately short, tight, or revealing shorts, skirts, dresses, tank tops, halter or crop tops, and spaghetti strap tops are prohibited. Skirts, dresses, and shorts must be at least mid-thigh length when the student is sitting.

Students who do not adhere to this policy will be asked to call home and make arrangements with a parent or guardian to have a change of clothing brought to the school. We appreciate your support and cooperation as we try our best to enforce this policy.


