\*MMHS Graduation Information: Our MMHS 2018 Graduation will take place on Thursday, May 24<sup>th</sup> at 2:00pm at the UCCU Special Events Center at UVU. School will dismiss at 11:15am to allow our students, faculty, and staff the time needed to prepare for graduation. WE WILL NOT BE SERVING BREAKFAST OR LUNCH ON THIS DAY; buses will run their routes. We encourage all students to attend graduation, if possible, to support our senior students. We are very proud of our graduating Class of 2018!!

**Graduation Practice** will be held on Tuesday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 8:00am at the UCCU Special Events Center at UVU. This is a mandatory practice for all senior students!! Please contact the counseling department if you will be unable to attend this practice. Transportation will be provided for senior students who will need a ride to graduation practice, and will depart from MMHS at 7:00am, returning back to the school at approximately 10:30am.
