STUDENT PARKING PERMITS

Students planning on using MMHS parking facilities need to register and pay for a parking permit. The permits are \$10 and can be paid for at the finance office. Beginning August 20, 2019 students may pick up their parking permits in the copy center before school, during lunch, or after school. There is a Student Vehicle Registration Form that needs to be completed before picking up this permits. SCHOOL PICTURE DAYS

ALC STUDENTS

MMHS students who will be attending the ALC need to be aware of the following:

- When our school is on an assembly schedule, please remember that the ALC bell and bus schedules DO NOT change. They run on their normal schedules each day!!!
- The bus picks up our ALC students in the bus lane, which is located outside by the parking lot of the Field House. Please be prompt when meeting the bus!!! They run on a very tight schedule, trying to pick-up high school students throughout the district and transporting them to the ALC building located in Salem, and cannot wait for students who are running late. Students who miss the ALC bus are responsible for working out their own transportation to the ALC – the bus will not return to pick-up late students.

Are you interested in serving on School Community Council?

Any parent/guardian interested in serving on the School Community Council for this school year should contact Holly Henderson (Dean of Students) at holly.henderson@nebo.edu by the end of the day on Thursday, August 22nd in order to be on the ballot. There are two parent member positions open. Council members are expected to attend monthly meetings every third Tuesday of the month from 3:00 - 4:00 pm while school is in session and serve for two school years if possible. There will also be two district-wide training meetings for new members.

What does the School Community Council do?

The purpose of the Council is to assist school leaders in creating school improvement plans and goals in order to address academic needs; provide a tie between the students, parents, and community to improve school culture; advise on issues influencing the school; and make recommendations regarding School LAND Trust funding. The council consists of parents, administration, and faculty members that have volunteered to serve.
