School Picture Day (Aug 31 & Sept 1): -- We will be rotating to the auditorium stage to have school pictures taken during English classes, so whichever day your student has English is the day they will have their picture taken. ACT Prep Class: Students who are interested in an ACT Prep Class can sign up now in the Finance Office. The classes will be September 19 and 26 from 8:00 to 11:30 a.m. The cost of the class is \$50 and includes a preparation book. See your Counselor or the Finance office if you have questions about the ACT or the prep class. The class will be limited to the first 32 students who sign up.

PSAT Test: The PSAT will be administered at MMHS on Wednesday, October 14, 2015. The PSAT serves as a practice test for the SAT as well as the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship, the PSAT must be taken during the Junior year. Register in the Finance Office, the regular cost of the test is \$20.00.

STUDENTS MAY REGISTER FOR A GUARANTEED SEAT AT A DISCOUNTED RATE OF \$15.00 ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 25TH.

Registration will continue on September 28th on a first come first serve basis at the \$20.00 rate. See your Counselor in you have questions or would like more information about the benefits of taking the PSAT.

Josten's Visit: Josten's are coming to our school on September 28 to meet with junior and senior students about graduation preparation (cap & gowns, class rings, announcements, etc.). Juniors will be excused at 9:00am to go to the auditorium for this meeting; and seniors will begin their meeting at the start of second period. ***Concurrent Enrollment:** We are excited to have many of our classes offer concurrent enrollment credit through UVU. If your student is enrolled in a concurrent enrollment course, please be aware of the following deadlines:
September 4 - Last day to complete UVU Admission with NO late fees. (A \$40 late admission fee begins September

6, added to the \$35 registration fee).

September 8 - Last day to complete UVU Admission WITH \$40 late fee.

September 8 - Last day to submit prerequisite test scores for math and English to the UVU CE office. This is Accuplacer or ACT scores. Accuplacer tests are offered every day after school in the upstairs computer lab. Cost of the test is \$5 paid to the finance office. Students must be enrolled at UVU prior to taking the Accuplacer test; the enrollment process usually takes 24-48 hours. [UVU prerequisites 2015](#)

September 10 - LAST day to complete course signup and tuition is DUE.

September 10 - ALL students registering for a concurrent enrollment course **MUST** turn in a parent permission form to Robyn Dunn (room C100 at MMHS). One completed form covers all CE courses for the school year.

Students will be dropped from their CE course if they do not have a signed permission form turned in to Mrs. Dunn.
