**PSAT Test:** The PSAT will be administered at MMHS on Wednesday, October 14, 2015. The PSAT serves as a practice test for the SAT as well as the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship, the PSAT must be taken during the Junior year. Register in the Finance Office, the regular cost of the test is \$20.00. STUDENTS MAY REGISTER FOR A GUARANTEED SEAT AT A DISCOUNTED RATE OF \$15.00 ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 25TH. Registration will continue on September 28th on a first come first serve basis at the \$20.00 rate. 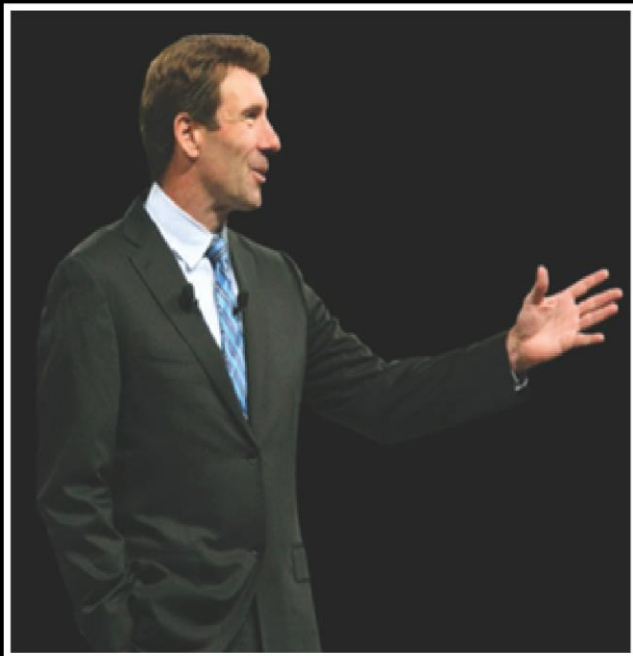

Hi, my name is **Heidi Whittaker**. I am a Parent Mentor with the Utah Parent Center. The Utah Parent Center has partnered with Nebo School District to provide free assistance to families of children with special educational needs. I, too, have a child receiving special education services in Nebo School District.

If your child has special needs, so do you! As a Parent Mentor, I can provide:

- information
- referral
- assistance

Services are offered to parents and professionals through the provision of one-on-one consultations. I can help you by:

- Providing a private consultation in-person, by e-mail or over the phone regarding questions or concerns about the special education process.
- Providing information on the IEP process and your rights and responsibilities under IDEA.
- Helping you prepare for IEP meetings and providing support during IEP meetings.
- Connecting you to resources and supports in your community.
- Providing information about upcoming events in the district and statewide.
