Parent Notification Information: We have had parents contacting us regarding information on how to receive our Monday e-mails and text messages from our school.

- **To receive our Monday e-mails:** Please review your student's SIS information to be sure contact information is accurate and your e-mail address is listed. If both parents would like to receive e-mails, be sure an e-mail address is listed for both parents.
- **To receive text messages:** Again, review the telephone information you have listed on your student's SIS account. To receive text messages from our school, go to the area where you list your "Main" phone number and "Other" numbers. Be sure your cell phone is listed in the "Other" area and that you select "Cellular" in the drop-down box. Even if your main number is also your cell phone number, list that number again in the "Other" section as a "Cellular" number. If both parents would like to receive text messages, follow these instructions to list "Cellular" numbers for both parents.

PSAT Test: The PSAT will be administered at MMHS on Wednesday, October 14, 2015. The PSAT serves as a practice test for the SAT as well as the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship, the PSAT must be taken during the Junior year. Register in the Finance Office, the regular cost of the test is \$20.00. STUDENTS MAY REGISTER FOR A GUARANTEED SEAT AT A DISCOUNTED RATE OF \$15.00 ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 25TH. Registration will continue on September 28th on a first come first serve basis at the \$20.00 rate. Services are offered to parents and professionals through the provision of one-on-one consultations. I can help you by:

- Providing information on the IEP process and your rights and responsibilities under IDEA.
- Helping you prepare for IEP meetings and providing support during IEP meetings.
- Connecting you to resources and supports in your community.
- Providing information about upcoming events in the district and statewide.
