#### **REGISTRATION: PAY ONLINE or MAIL-IN**

Registration will be accepted from now through August 11, 2017.

- 1. Registration fees may be paid on-line or mailed to the school
- 2. Update and verify your student's contact information: update phone numbers and addresses through your Aspire account that can be accessed at the Nebo School District Website. Click on the Parent Tab then scroll down to Aspire and log in. If you have forgotten your password, feel free to call the MMHS counseling department @ 801-794-6745.
- 3. Parking Permit Application can be found on the MMHS Website: www.mmhs.nebo.edu

When your registration is processed, you will have access to your class schedule online through Aspire.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAYING ONLINE

- To pay online, Log on to <a href="https://www.myschoolfees.com">www.myschoolfees.com</a> from your home computer
- Select the "new" My School Fees Link
- Click on Register and create a user name and password
- Your log in/user name will be your email address
- The password will be of your choice, one you create
- Click on UT-Nebo-Maple Mountain for your school
- Enter your student's SIS number to bring up your fees
- Click on Registration
- In the box that will come up to the right click the fees you wish to pay
- When you are finished click check out and enter your credit card information
- A receipt will be sent to your email

#### CLASS SCHEDULE AND ADJUSTMENTS

- Schedules may be viewed online through August 13 by accessing your Student Aspire Account.
- Access to the "schedule change feature" will be activated after students have completed the registration process and paid required fees. Access needs to be activated by school employees, so please expect a 24-hour processing time during the work week (M-F). No activation can take place over the weekend.
- Students may adjust class schedules on-line at no charge
- <u>All</u> counselor assisted schedule adjustments are made by completing a request form including a \$10 fee
- Important Dates:
  - July 27 Aug 11: **Seniors** are encouraged to make individual appointments with their assigned counselor (If you are unable to attend your scheduled appointment, please call in advance.
  - August 2-11: All other seniors will be seen on a space available basis
  - August 14-15: All counselors will be available
  - August 16-8: District Development Days -- Counselors will NOT be available
- Written requests for schedule adjustments, including the \$10.00 fee, will be accepted through August 29
- Schedules will be considered final and no further requests will be accepted after August 29

#### **PARKING PERMITS**

For school safety and security purposes, all students who drive a vehicle to school are required to obtain and display a parking permit. Parking permit applications may be found on our school website. After an application has been completed, students need to pay a \$10 parking permit fee to our finance office and take their receipt to the security office (located in the front office) to receive their permit.

#### **FEE WAIVERS**

You must apply for and meet with an administrator at our school to be granted a fee waiver. To receive a fee waiver you must meet one of the following guidelines:

- Qualify for free school lunch (reduced lunch does not qualify for fee waivers)
- Receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments
- Receive Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC)

All students who qualify for a fee waiver will be given the opportunity to work off the cost of their fees. When you meet with an administrator to qualify for the fee waiver, you may select the method to be used to earn your fees.

An administrator will be in the school on August 1-2 (T-W), from 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., to assist those who desire to apply for a fee waiver. Please bring one of the following to qualify:

- A copy of your 2015 Income Tax Return
- Verification of receiving SSI payments
- Verification of receiving AFDC payments

It is necessary that each family be approved annually. Last year's application is not valid. Questions concerning fee waiver eligibility may be answered by calling the Nebo School District Office at 801-354-7400, or Maple Mountain High School at 801-794-6740.

#### **IMMUNIZATIONS**

State law requires that all students have a current immunization record before being admitted into school. If you are new to our district, please be sure this is completed before school starts.
