 2. Selling gourmet Rice Crispy Treats at the Spanish Fork City Park on a night they do the food truck gathering.  
 Money will be collected from individuals who purchase a treat from any of the cheerleaders at the park on the evening of May 10th. Parents will be there with a cashbox and money envelope.  
 Both activities will be done as a team and funds will be accounted as a team number rather than individual balances since we will be working on both projects all together.

We have 4 parents signed up to advise and help with each activity. They will help with transportation to the neighborhoods where the girls will be painting numbers.
