Dear Parents/Guardians:

Maple Mountain High School is pleased to partner with Utah Valley University (UVU) to provide Concurrent Enrollment (CE) courses. Online enrollment for Spring Semester classes at UVU has begun. If your student is enrolled in a class at MMHS next semester that offers Concurrent Enrollment credit, we strongly encourage you to have your student complete the admissions process for UVU immediately. Once they have been admitted to UVU as a Concurrent Enrollment student, they can register for classes. It takes about 48-72 hours for the admitting process to be finalized. There is a \$35 one-time registration fee payable online to UVU.

Here are the enrollment deadlines for UVU. Please keep in mind that **UVU does NOT extend deadlines!**

January 25

- Last day to complete UVU Admission
- Last day to submit prerequisite Accuplacer test scores, PLAN test scores, transcripts, and/or ACT scores to UVU's concurrent enrollment office
- Last day to submit "Sophomore by Exception Application" with completed prerequisites
 - Sophomores MUST complete this application each semester to apply for concurrent enrollment courses. Students submit this form to Mrs. Dunn in C100 and she will upload it to UVU's site for final approval.

- Last day to complete course sign-up
