Dear Parents/Guardians

Maple Mountain High School is pleased to partner with Utah Valley University (UVU) to provide Concurrent Enrollment (CE) courses. Online enrollment for Spring Semester classes at UVU has begun. If your student is enrolled in a class at MMHS this semester that offers Concurrent Enrollment credit, we strongly encourage you to have your student complete the admissions process for UVU immediately. Once they have been admitted to UVU as a Concurrent Enrollment student, they can register for classes. It takes about 48-72 hours for the admitting process to be finalized. There is a \$35 one-time registration fee payable online to UVU. If your student is enrolled in a **year-long** concurrent enrollment course (ENG1010, BIO1010, Math1050, PES2400, HIST1700, etc.) they do not need to re-register for those classes.

The deadline for enrolling and registering for classes is **this week**. Here are the deadlines for UVU:

### **January 21 (Wednesday!)**

- Last day to complete UVU Admission
- Last day to submit prerequisite Accuplacer test scores, transcripts, and/or ACT scores to the CE office
- Last day to submit "Sophomore by Exception Application" with completed prerequisites

### **January 23 (Friday!)**
