MAPLE MOUNTAIN HIGH SCHOOL ELLEVÉS TAKE REGION

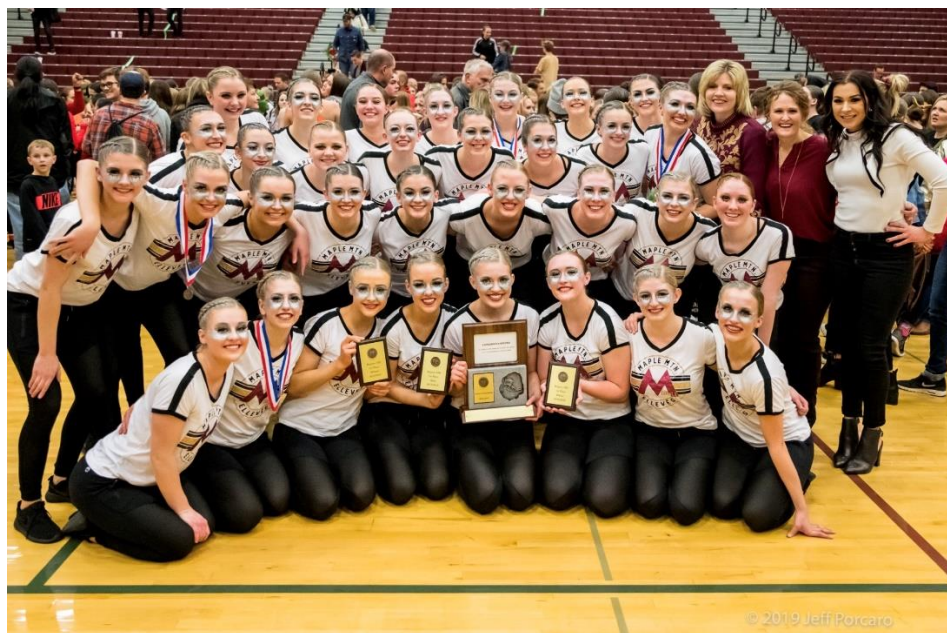
The Maple Mountain High School Ellevés competed at the Region VIII Drill Team Competition held at Maple Mountain High School on Thursday, January 24, 2019. The Ellevés placed 1st in the Military category; 1st in the Dance category, and 1st in the Kick category. Overall the Ellevés placed 1st and were awarded the Region VIII trophy. Four Ellevés placed in the drill down. Abbie Jackson, daughter of John and Kallie Jackson, placed 5th, Carlie Tippets, daughter of Mike and Angie Tippets, placed 3rd, Brynn Belka, daughter of Byron and Monica Belka, placed 2nd, and Kacey Melton, daughter of Aaron and Tanya Melton, placed 1st. Three Maple Mountain High School Ellevés were named to the All-Region Drill Team. They are Valerie Friant, daughter of Craig and Jadean Friant; Baylee Hite, daughter of Chaden and Marci Hite; and Kacey Melton, daughter of Aaron and Tanya Melton. Qualifications for this honor were drill team members who have been an active member of drill team for two years or more, having an excellent attitude, unifying the team, going the extra mile, having great sportsmanship, and being respectable and dependable. They must also have above average grades and citizenship.

The Ellevés also had seven seniors receive the Academic All-Region award. To qualify for this award, they must be a senior and have a grade point average of 3.7 or higher. Those receiving the award are: Annika Christensen, Valerie Friant, Baylee Hite, Kacey Melton, Jentrie Reid, Gabi Smith and Carlie Tippets.

The "Hero" award, which is given to one member on each of the drill teams, was given to Carlie Tippets.

It will be an eventful afternoon full of knowledge from higher education schools to help our juniors start thinking about life after high school.

Junior PCCR's

Junior PCCR's (Plan for College and Career Readiness) will be held January 22- February 1. Junior students should check their student email for a registration link from Sign Up Genius to sign up for a time that works with their schedule. Parents may also receive the link. Students who have not signed up by January 21 will be assigned a meeting time.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMS

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Maple Mountain High School desires that all students take AP exams for the AP classes that they have taken. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition. For the 2019 AP exams, students at Maple Mountain High School will be registering online. This registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access.

Online Exam registration will begin on Wed, Jan 2, 2019 at 12:00 AM and end on Wed, Mar 6, 2019 at 11:59 PM. In order to register, students should click on the link provided on the school website or visit www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/450423 to register. To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end. We know that parents may desire to register their students for exams. We strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.

Maple Mountain High School is excited to offer families the convenience of paying exam fees online at the time of registration. Please be sure to have a **credit card or debit card available before beginning registration**. Paying online is a great way to make sure that payment has been made while avoiding mailing payment. This year each AP exam costs \$99.00.

Here are the important dates for the registration process:

- Wed, Jan 2, 2019 at 12:00 AM - Registration Begins
- Wed, Mar 6, 2019 at 11:59 PM - Registration Ends
- Mon, Mar 11, 2019 at 11:59 PM - Registrations that have not been paid for will be cancelled and exams will not be ordered.

UVU Concurrent Enrollment Deadlines

MMHS is proud to partner with UVU in providing concurrent enrollment courses. Please be aware of the quickly approaching deadlines:

January 18 -- Last day to complete UVU Admissions. Cost to enroll at UVU is \$35 payable online to UVU.

January 23 -

Last day to submit Sophomore by Exception forms and Accuplacer scores. Students can take their completed form with transcript to Mrs. Dunn in C100 by 3 p.m. The sophomore Accuplacer test is required and costs \$10 in the Finance Office.

The sophomore exception form can be found on UVU's

Last day to Submit ACT/Accuplacer scores for math. Senior math students who did **NOT** earn a C or better in Secondary Math 1, 2, or 3 and a C or better in MAT1010 must submit a transcript showing qualifying ACT scores OR take the Accuplacer test if their ACT scores are not high enough. Accuplacer tests are offered every day after school in the upstairs computer lab. Cost of the test is \$5. Students should enroll at UVU prior to taking the Accuplacer test. January 25 - Last day to complete course sign-up for Juniors & Seniors. Tuition due. Tuition is \$5 per credit.

January 25 - **ALL** students registering for a concurrent enrollment course **MUST** turn in a parent permission form to UVU.
