2022-2023 REGISTRATION

Parents, PLEASE take a few minutes to register your students for the upcoming school year! This process needs to be completed each school year. You will not need to pay the fees at this time.

Online Registration Instructions

- 1. Log in to your parent portal for Infinite Campus. You can find this under the Parents tab at www.nebo.edu. If you have forgotten your username or need to re-set your password, please call the counseling office at 801-794-6745.
- 2. Once you log in, choose the **More** option at the bottom left of the page.
- 3. Choose the **Online Registration** option on the next page. From here, the process is pretty straightforward. You will verify and/or update your information, such as address, phone number, emergency contacts. This is also the place to sign school policies, such as the Computer Use Agreement.
- 4. Be sure to click the Submit button at the end.

ACT ASPIRE EXAMS FOR SOPHOMORE STUDENTS

During the week of Tuesday, April 19th to Friday, April 22nd, all of our sophomore students will be taking the ACT Aspire Exams in their core classes. This test is a hybrid of the ACT and Utah State Core. We highly encourage students to give their best effort because this test will give them a predictive score in preparation for taking the ACT next year. Each section of the test will be taken in their English, Math, and Science classes over the course of these four days.

Like the ACT, the test is timed and once a student starts each section of the test it must be finished in that sitting. They can't leave early and come back and finish the section at a later time. We ask for your help in encouraging your student to be on time to all of their classes and to give their best effort on these exams. Also like the ACT, the ACT Aspire is an online exam and must be taken on a school issued chrome book. Students will need to bring their chrome books fully charged and ready to go on the morning of the test. We will have a limited number of chrome books available for those students who do not have a school issued chrome book that they can check-out through the copy center.

If you choose to not have your student participate in the assessments, this form must be signed and returned to the Counseling Office at Maple Mountain.

Also, please understand that if your student is marked absent or tardy by mistake, they need to visit with the teacher and request to have it removed or changed, then the teacher will contact the attendance office requesting a correction. The attendance office cannot remove or change an attendance mark without receiving verification from a teacher.
