The PSAT will be administered at MMHS on Saturday, October 15, 2016. The PSAT serves as a practice test for the SAT as well as the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship. Sophomores and Juniors may take the test. In order to be considered for the National Merit Scholarship, the PSAT must be taken during the Junior year. Register in the Finance Office, the cost of the test is \$15.00 and will be limited to 50 students.
