**\*ACT Prep Class:** Students who are interested in an ACT prep class can sign up now in the Finance Office. The classes will be September 20 and 27 from 8:00 to 11:30 a.m. The cost of the class is \$50 and includes a preparation book. Mark Tanner will cover English and Reading on September 20, and Greg Henry will cover Math and Science on September 27. **\*PSAT Test:** The PSAT will be administered at MMHS on Wednesday, October 15, 2014. The PSAT serves as a practice test for the SAT as well as the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship. Sophomores and Juniors may take the test. In order to be considered for the National Merit Scholarship, the PSAT must be taken during the Junior year. Register in the Finance Office, the regular cost of the test is \$20. Students may register for a guaranteed seat at a discounted rate of \$15, on or before September 26. Registration will continue on September 29 on a first come first served basis at the \$20 rate. See your Counselor if you have questions or would like more information about the benefits of taking PSAT.

**\*Concurrent Enrollment:** Concurrent enrollment deadlines:

**September 5** - Last day to complete UVU Admission with NO late fees. (A \$40 late admission fee begins September 6, added to the \$35 registration fee).

**September 10** - Last day to complete UVU Admission WITH \$40 late fee.

**September 10** - Last day to submit prerequisite test scores for Math, Biology and English to the UVU CE office. This is Accuplacer or ACT scores. Accuplacer tests are offered every day after school in the upstairs computer lab. Cost of the test is \$5. Students must be enrolled at UVU prior to taking the Accuplacer test, enrollment usually takes 24-48 hours.
